Transportation to the Fair

Shuttles will run every 30 minutes each day during the Fair's operating hours from the Arlington Career Center, Virginia Square Metro, Wakefield High School and the I-66 parking garage. The last shuttle departs the Fair shuttle stop 10 minutes after the Fair closes. A \$2 round-trip fee is charged for shuttle services and will be collected upon arrival at the Fair. Children 12 and under and seniors 65 and over ride for free. ADA parking is available at the Fair in front of the Thomas Jefferson Community Center, along 2nd Street South with on-street parallel parking.

There is no public parking at the Fair and parking on nearby streets is restricted to neighborhood residents with temporary permits only.

We also offer free valet bike parking on our tennis courts through a partnership with BikeArlington and Two Wheel Valet. We encourage you to check out CarFreeDiet.com for information on other car-free transportation options.


