Over the past half-decade, the Fair has experienced remarkable growth, more than doubling our attendance—a testament to the vibrant spirit and unwavering support of our community. We've also diligently strengthened our financial foundation, substantially increasing our cash reserves to ensure the fair's sustained success and vibrancy for years to come.

A historic development this year marks a new chapter in our collaborative efforts. For the first time in almost 50 years, the Fair Board has successfully transitioned operational control of logistics, security, and vendor management to the capable hands of the Arlington County Department of Parks and Recreation. This strategic partnership liberates the Board to concentrate entirely on its core mission: fostering equal opportunities for entertainment for all fairgoers and curating a robust and compelling competitive exhibits program that showcases the diverse talents of our residents.

We are particularly thrilled to be offering over \$30,000 in free entertainment to all fairgoers this year, thanks to generous fundraising efforts with dedicated partners, most notably our title sponsor, Amazon. Their commitment, along with that of many others, allows us to uphold our mission of providing accessible, high-quality entertainment for everyone.

Our success is built on partnerships, and I want to extend a special note of appreciation to the Arlington Heights Civic Association. Their invaluable support and collaborative spirit have been instrumental in improving the fair experience, particularly in facilitating the successful relocation of the beer garden to the upper field. This move has not only enhanced the fair's amenities but also significantly improved traffic flow for fairgoers along 2nd Street, contributing to a smoother and more enjoyable visit.

Transportation to the Fair

Parking

Public parking at the Fair is limited to patrons with valid ADA parking tags. There is NO public parking in the garage located on S. Old Glebe Road. Patrons that attempt to park in the garage on TJ property will be towed. Parking on nearby streets is restricted to neighborhood residents with temporary permits.

ADA Parking

The grounds are accessible. ADA parking spaces are available with an ADA tag in the main parking lot off 2nd St (in front of the community center).

Shuttles

The shuttle stop will be located at the Ballston Mall Parking Garage (627 N Glebe Rd) near the corner of N Randolph and N Glebe Rd. Two and a half blocks from the Ballston-MU Metro Station (Orange/Silver Line). Shuttles will operate a half hour before the fair opens to a half hour after it closes, and continuously between the Ballston Mall Parking Garage and the fairgrounds. Parking at the Ballston Mall Garage starts at \$1 for three hours. Shuttles will be operated by ART Bus.

Rideshare / Drop-off and Pick-Up Area

There is a designated spot for drop-off/pick-up only on eastbound 2nd St S, at the corner of Old S Glebe Rd. Vehicles that idle in this location for more than two minutes will be asked to move.



Biking and Scootering

Biking or scootering are some of the easiest, fun, and sustainable ways to get to the Arlington County Fair. Bike Arlington and partner Two Wheel Valet have teamed up to provide free bike parking on our tennis courts all five days of the fair! It is unstaffed on Wednesday and Thursday and staffed on Friday, Saturday, and Sunday. Please bring your own lock for personal bikes! For questions on bicycle parking and biking in general, visit the Bike Arlington tent. There, you'll also find a Lime tent and parking for electric scooters!

Public Transportation

Public transportation options beyond the free shuttle from the Ballston Mall Parking Garage include ART Bus 41, Metrobus 10B, and Metrobus 23A/23C. Visit arlingtoncountyfair.us for more information, maps, and timetables!

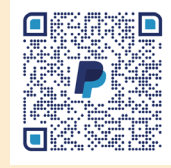

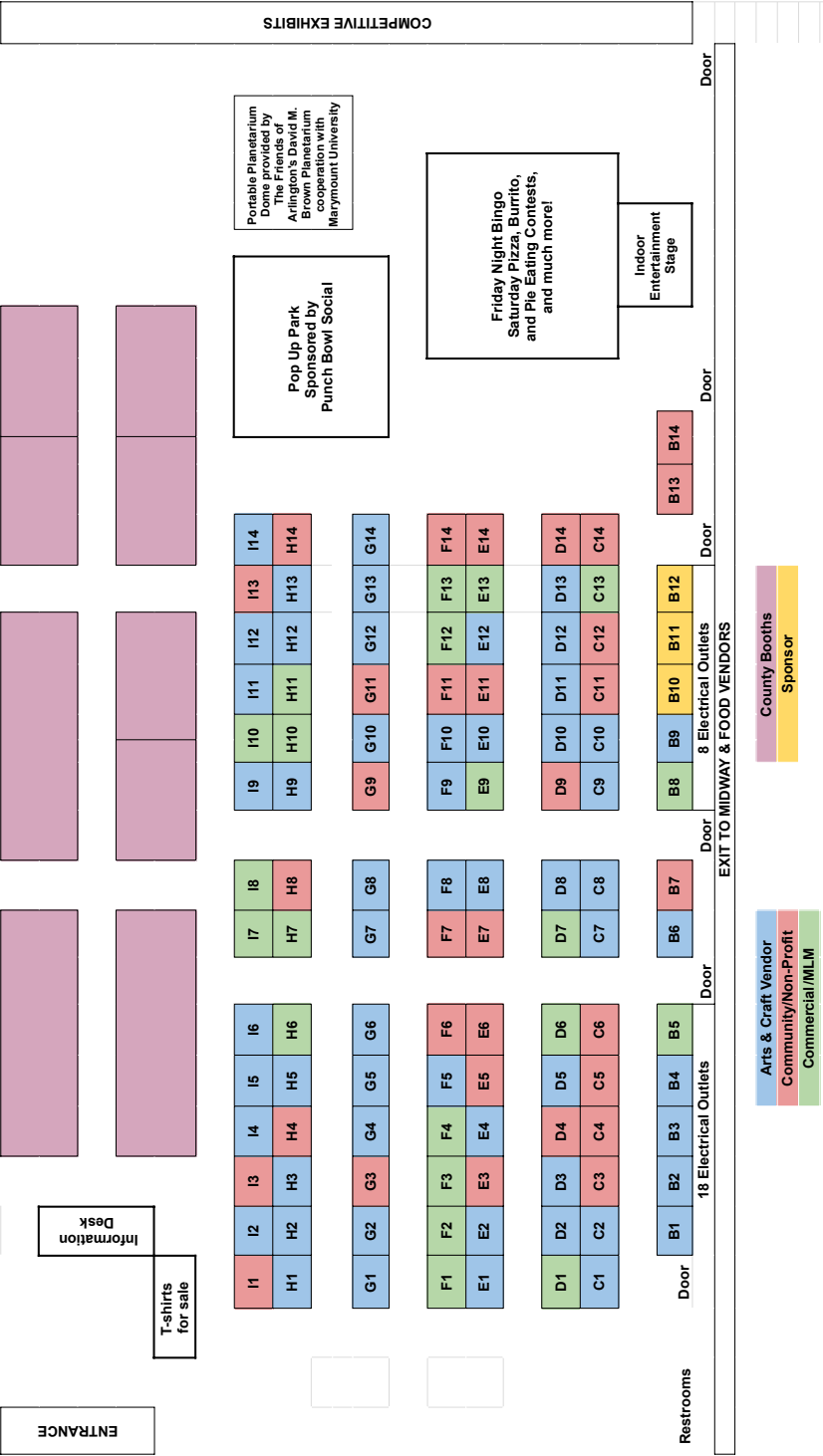
